**Regional Spatial Strategy (RSS) for the South West: Review of Additional Pitch Requirements for Gypsies and Travellers - Publication of the Panel Report**

Please find enclosed the Report of the Panel appointed by the Secretary of State to examine the Regional Spatial Strategy for the South West: Review of Additional Pitch Requirements for Gypsies and Travellers. The Examination in Public was held in March 2008.

The Report, prepared by an independent Panel of Planning Inspectors, was submitted to Government on 28<sup>th</sup> April 2008. It is being published today for information only. Representations are not invited on its recommendations.



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The Secretary of State will consider the Report, along with all the representations previously submitted and will incorporate pitch requirements for Gypsies and Travellers in Proposed Changes to the draft RSS which she aims to publish in Summer 2008. There will then be a twelve week period of public consultation on the proposed changes.

Following consideration of comments and views arising from that consultation, the Secretary of State is expecting to publish the final RSS by the end 2008.
